1. I understand that alpine skiing, other competitive and sports activities are HAZARDOUS ACTIVITIES. I understand that alpine skiing, and the use of skis, other equipment and lifts involves risk of injury to any and all parts of my body. I understand that there are numerous risks and dangers inherent in the sport of alpine skiing and other activities including but not limited to: surface or sub-surface snow or ice conditions whether natural or machine-made, the unevenness of the surface which contains rocks, bumps, ruts, stumps, the steepness of the terrain, jumps, ramps, terrain elements and other features, whether natural or man-made, collisions with other trail users, trees, poles, posts, fences or objects. I understand that having a Waterville Valley Ski Resort, Inc. (WVSRI) employee present does not lessen the amount or severity of the risks of these activities. I understand that WVSRI is not responsible for my safety. It is further understood that training or racing competitively is more HAZARDOUS than recreational skiing. Furthermore, I understand that I must keep deliberate and conscious control of my physical body, both on the ground and in the air, while properly using my equipment in variable weather, snow and terrain conditions.
2. I hereby certify that I am physically fit and have no medical conditions or allergies that affect my ability to participate in these activities.
