

JIII-IV-V KANDAHAR FESTIVAL



Labrador Mountain - Truxton, New York

February 26-February 27, 2011

The Kandahar Festival is a two-day giant slalom race open to Jr. V, IV, and III racers from the Central and Adirondack Councils. JV racers ages 7 to 10 years old (YOB '00 to '03) may compete in the Festival, however, JV racers must be 9 or 10 years old by December 31, 2010 (YOB '00 and '01) to qualify to the Kandahar Championship Race. Only Jr. IV and Jr. III racers who are not attending their respective State Championship races are eligible to compete. All participants must be NYSSRA and USSA members prior to the event.

REGISTRATION

Entries must be received by February 24, 2011 at midnight and are limited to the first 200 received. No late race entries will be accepted.

SEEDING

Bib assignment will represent random draw within each gender and age group each day. The order of racing for both days will be Jr. V Girls followed by Jr. V Boys, then Jr. IV Girls followed by JIV Boys, and finally Jr. III Girls followed by Jr. III Boys. The second run is reverse order in each gender and age group. Did-Not-Finish (DNF) and Disqualification (DSQ)

racers will be permitted to run in order for the second run. The start order will be re-randomized within each age group and gender for the second day of racing.

RACE SCHEDULE FOR BOTH DAYS

Saturday, February 26, 2011 and Sunday, February 27, 2011 races will take place on Cut Throat.

7:30-8:30 am	Racer and Coach Registration in the LMSC Race Hut. Officials and volunteers sign-in and receive lift tickets. Start orders will be provided at registration.
8:00 am	Coaches Meeting outside of the Main Lodge.
8:30	Gate Judges Meeting outside of the LMSC Race Hut.
8:15-9:15 am	Course open for inspection.
9:15 am	Course inspection closes. Racers, Gate Judges and Race Officials report to top of course.
9:25 am	Forerunners start.
9:30 am	First Run start.

Second Run Course Inspection begins 60 minutes after the conclusion of the First Run.

Upon completion of the second run, bibs will be collected in the finish area. On Saturday, all racers MUST make sure their bib is collected at the finish, or turned into the bib collection bin in the LMSC Race Hut. Different bibs will be assigned for Sunday's race.

Helmets are mandatory.

Disqualification (DSQ) and Did-Not-Finish (DNF) assignments will be posted in the Old Bar of the Main Lodge at the conclusion of each run. Any protests must be made in writing to a jury member within 15 minutes of posting. A protest fee of \$50 applies.

It is expected that all racers, coaches, officials, volunteers, and parents will comply with the NYSSRA Sportsman Code of Conduct. All USSA and NYSSRA rules apply. For details, please review your 2010-2011 USSA and NYSSRA manuals.

AWARDS

Awards will take place on the desk between the Main Lodge and The Last Run, approximately 45 hour after the completion of the race.

On Sunday, six (6) Skimeister awards will be awarded by NYSSRA to the top male and female in each age class based on the best combined place points using all four runs.

Athletes will be named to the March 6, 2011 Kandahar Championships based on the best 2 of 6 results including single runs and combined result. Ties will be broken by the next best run.

Jr. V - 9 Girls and 7 Boys (Racers must be 9 years old by 12/31/10 to qualify.)

Jr. IV - 4 Girls and 5 Boys

Jr. III - 3 Girls and 5 Boys

Selected racers will need to decline or commit and pay the \$40 race entry to the Kandahar Championship at Holiday Valley at this time. Registration for the Championships will be held in the LMSC Race Hut following the announcements.
